## PIANO

### REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 3 - Grade 7
- Own piano or keyboard (minimum 30 keys)
- Piano book (to be conveyed)
- Theory book (see music theory)

### NOTE:

Private piano lessons can be arranged for those that cannot be accommodated at school (Grade 1-7).

## RECORDER

### REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 3 - Grade 5
- Own **Soprano Yamaha White** recorder
- 20 page flip file
- Theory book (see music theory)

### NOTE:

**Alto (Yamaha White)** recorder lessons commence in Grade 4.

## BRASS

### REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 4 - Grade 6
- Own instrument or rented instrument
- 20 page flip file
- Theory book (see music theory)

### NOTE:

Brass instruments can be hired from the school at an additional R 150-00 per term.

*Incl: Trumpet ,Trombone, French Horn, Tuba, Euphonium*

## WOODWIND

### REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 4 - Grade 6
- Own instrument or rented instrument
- Music book (to be conveyed)
- Theory book (see music theory)

### NOTE:

Woodwind instruments can be hired from the school at an additional R 150-00 per term.

*Incl: Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone*

## DRUMS

### REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 4 - Grade 7
- Own drum kit
- Drum kit book (to be conveyed)
- Theory book (see music theory)

### NOTE:

Percussion tuition is also available, but not during covid-19.

## CHOIRS

### JUNIOR CHOIR (Grade 2-3)

- SENIOR choir practices are held in the mornings before school as well as after school

## ENSEMBLES

### DJEMBES (Grade 1-3)

- Learners are invited to join the djembes following successful auditions
- Learners with their own djembes, can join the group at any time
- Djembe practices are held in the mornings before school
- Practice schedules to be confirmed

### BRASS ENSEMBLE (Grade 4-7)

- Brass players are invited to join the brass ensemble when they have reached the required level
- Brass ensemble practices are held in the mornings before school
- Practice schedules to be confirmed

## BANDS

### WINDBAND (Grade 4-7)

- Wind instrument players are invited to join the windband when they have reached the required level
- Windband practices are held in the mornings before school
- Practice schedules to be confirmed

### BEAT WAVES (Grade 4-7)
