According to the Policy

"Parents will then have to personally fetch the report from the class teacher or an (*) authorised person may be nominated. The reason for this is that it is the final promotion of your child and that it is a sensitive and confidential document.

No report will be handed to any child or parent outside this policy. We regard every child's report as a confidential record. No report will ever be held back, however, the Principal may request that the report should be collected personally from his office if there is sufficient merit for this. Parents should be notified of such a decision timeously (10 days' notice.)

- (*) An authorised person can only qualify to fetch the report if the following three requirements were met:
- 1) The parent sends an e-mail to <u>info@sunridge.co.za</u> or a letter with the written request to hand the report to the person, stating the full names and ID no of the person, as well as the name and grade of the child. This e-mail or letter must reach the school 3 work days **before** the last school day of that particular term or **10 day**s before the predetermined date in the last term.
- 2) The person comes to the school at the given time, with his/her ID as well as the written request by the parent.
- 3) The person must be 18 years or older."
