Sunridge is hosting the semi-finals with all three of our rugby teams playing for a spot in the finals. These matches, like all other matches, are subject to the rules and regulations of the specific sports code. We cannot interfere with match officials and they can request that anyone breaking the rules leave the premises - as a school we will comply and assist them.

Rules on the field of play and what players do or say is also under the jurisdiction of the match officials, irrespective of any view or opinion. The school rules apply at all times.

Only coaches can address any unhappiness with the match officials via a written report to the applicable forum. We are proud that the vast majority of our parents respect this and although they sometimes disagree they behave responsibly and refrain from making unwanted comments or disrespectful behavior.

"Two wrongs do not make a right" applies and as always, the one who retaliates is the one who will pay the price. It is the right thing to do and we expect everyone to keep to the high moral ground. Sunridge parents are well known for their compassion and moral values. Let us not give in to the few and keep them to our standard. Please step in and calm them down and support them should they have a vulnerable or weak emotional moment.

In accordance with Boksmart rules and regulations, we will cordon off our fields. Only officials accredited for the match and with Boksmart accreditation will be allowed on the field of play. We have appointed Boksmart accredited officials to assist with monitoring spectators.

We humbly request all parents to assist on the day - enjoy the match and let us build relationships and friendships for the future. We all want to win BUT we need to do so with respect and our moral responsibility. We need to respect that there will be losers and we need to deal with it irrespective of any matters outside of our control.

Last Saturday we saw learners and parents shed a tear because they had played/ supported their last match for Sunridge. Emotions of enjoyment and camaraderie are worth more than the result of the match.

Should you struggle with your emotions, I can assure you that sitting on the pavilion is the best place to be. Bring your pillow, hat, sunglasses, rain jacket and take your seat on the pavilion to enjoy the game. The coaches have done what they can to prepare their players - it is now up to the players and the match officials to decide on the outcome on the field of play.

Ons kan nie met wedstrydbeamptes inmeng nie en hulle kan versoek dat enigiemand wat die reëls oortree, die terrein verlaat. Ons, as skool, sal aan die versoek moet voldoen en hulle ondersteun.

Reëls op die speelveld en wat spelers doen of sê, val ook onder die jurisdiksie van die wedstrydbeampte, ongeag enige ander sienswyse of mening. Die skoolreëls geld te alle tye.




