Dear Parents

Ons het buitemuurse aktiwiteite na die beste van ons vermoë beperk gedurende die toetsreeks. Al drie spanne sal hul titels van 2023 verdedig en ons beste wense vergesel hulle. Ongeag die uitkoms, is ons trots op ons seuns se prestasies.

Met die OP Superreeks-eindstryd wat Saterdag deur OPPSRV by Framesby aangebied word, versoek ons weereens dat ouers, spelers en afrigters die wedstrydbeamptes en die wedstryd respekteer deur hulle te weerhou van ongewenste aanmerkings en gedrag voor, gedurende en ná die wedstryd. Kom ons handhaaf die stilswey soos ons gedoen het gedurende die halfeindstryde wat by Sunridge plaasgevind het. Ons netbalmeisies het heerlike pret gehad met hul wedstryde teen die personeel en 'n wonderlike positiewe gees het geheers.

Leerlinge is weereens betrap waar hulle gedurende skoolure met hul selfone foto's neem, ens. Dit is duidelik dat die grense getoets word en, hoewel ons nie ons wetlike reg wil uitoefen om leerlinge te deursoek nie, sal ons binnekort dalk verplig word om dit te doen. Maak asseblief seker dat u kind nie 'n selfoon skool toe bring nie. Ons is heeltemal in staat om ouers gedurende 'n noodgeval te kontak en die kind moet net om hulp vra.

Die somer kom stadig nader en binnekort sal die laaste koue dae waarskynlik iets van die verlede wees.
